WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY (WHS) POLICY

Commitment

The Management, Employees and Contractors of ROMA TRANSPORT & CRANE SERVICES recognises its obligation to take all reasonable precautions to provide and maintain an environment that is safe and is without risks or injury.

Management Responsibility

- Establish and maintain a WHS management system that facilitates a structured approach to the management of WHS risk
- Provide adequate human financial and time resources to ensure the effectiveness and sustainability of the system
- Keep up to date with relevant Qld WHS legislative obligations. Achieve and maintain compliance with these obligations
- Promote a safety culture that encourages the people to proactively manage WHS risk through education, instruction, information and supervision
- Clearly define and communicate staff, contractors and contractor responsibilities in relation to WHS
- Proactively identify and manage WHS risk via a documented hazard identification, risk assessment, risk control and monitoring process
- Improve processes that insure that incidents and hazards are promptly reported, investigated where appropriate, and control measures are put in place to eliminate and minimise the chance of a repeat event
- Maintain building infrastructure, plant and equipment in a safe condition with documented safe systems of work
- Routinely monitor and review WHS performance to achieve continual improvement
- Ensure that all RTS operations comply with Chain of Responsibility legislative requirements

Employees Responsibilities

All Employees are to comply with EHS Manual generally and:

- Must take all reasonable care for their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by their conduct at the workplace
- Must not wilfully or recklessly interfere with or misuse anything provided in the health and safety or welfare and must cooperate with ROMA TRANSPORT & CRANE SERVICES in relation to actions taken by this company to comply with Qld WHS Legislation
- Must not wilfully place at risk the health and safety of any person in the workplace

Contractors Responsibilities

All contractors are to comply with the EHS Manual generally and in addition Contractors:

- Are responsible for adopting safe work and study practices
- Must not wilfully place at risk the health and safety of any person at ROMA TRANSPORT & CRANE SERVICES
- Must not wilfully or recklessly interfere with or misuse anything provided in the interests of health and safety or welfare and must cooperate with ROMA TRANSPORT & CRANE SERVICES in relation to actions taken to comply with Qld WHS Legislation

Consultation

ROMA TRANSPORT & CRANE SERVICES is committed to encouraging consultation and cooperation between management and employees. For this purpose, it will establish a Workplace Health and Safety Committee (WHSC) which in turn will encourage the election of employee Workplace Health and Safety Representative (WHSR) who are consulted and involved in any workplace changes which could affect health and Safety
